TOURISM REGIONS

BULAWAYO

Bulawayo is Zimbabwe's second-largest city. It is known as "The City of Kings" because of the Ndebele chiefs who ruled in the area after breaking away from Zululand in the south. The city has a rich history and is a Zimbabwe cultural hub with people from different ethnic backgrounds converging on what the early settlers referred to as the "city of opportunity". The influx of "tourists" from very far places intending to see the King with their various requests and proposals spurred the growth a settlement around King Lobengula's home in Emahlabathini.

It's a gateway to Matobo National Park that offers a diverse package of tourist attractions and activities such as escorted walks, fishing, boating, game viewing, bird watching, hiking, rhino tracking and rock painting sites. Matobo National Park is also well known for its unique balancing rock features with the popular "**mother and child**" **balancing rocks**. Nearby the Tshabalala Game Sanctuary has zebra and impala.

LOCOMOTIVES ON DISPLAY AT THE RAILWAY MUSEUM

West of Bulawayo, the ruins of 15th-century Khami city comprise stone walls and terraces. Bulawayo is home to the biggest and best museum not only in the country but in the whole sub-Saharan Africa, the Natural History Museum of Zimbabwe. It is also the only city in the country with three museums, the other two being the Railway Museum and the Joshua Nkomo Museum.

Other interesting features in the city include the Joshua Nkomo statue standing at the heart of the city, the Art Gallery, which is a historic building, the Exchange Building where Cecil Rhodes used to exchange gold and a host of other buildings with great history.

Makokoba the oldest township is the original home of the arts, entertainment and sport. Shebeen culture, Afro-jazz music, boxing and soccer in the city have their origins in Makokoba. The market (umkambo) in Makokoba continues to attract tourists with a wide array of merchandise including African traditional medicines, which are popular with visitors.

Bulawayo has grown to be a formidable giant in (Meetings Incentives Conventions and Events (MICE) tourism in Zimbabwe with the Zimbabwe International Exhibition Centre being the flagship facility. A fulfilling and informative tour of Bulawayo is best undertaken with a tour guide who is good with history. Outside the CBD, the Hillside Dams are a popular spot for recreation. The Central and **Centenary Parks** are also good rendezvous for relaxing with family and friends. Certainly one cannot exhaust Bulawayo in one day or on one page.

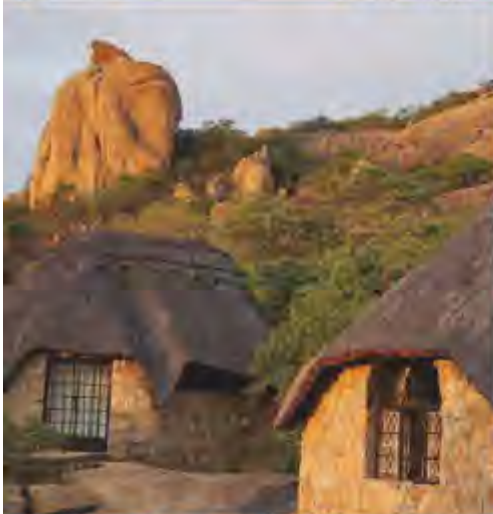

KHAMI RUINS


Khami was the capital of the Torwa elite of the Butua State who ruled from about AD 1450 until a civil war and intervention by the Portuguese led to its destruction and abandonment around 1644. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site located 22km west of Bulawayo. The Ruins have a series of terraces and passages supported by massive granite walls, some overlooking the Khami Gorge and Khami Dam that was built in 1928. A small museum displays relics found at the site.



The "mysterious cross." A lot of theories have been postulated regarding this but a general consensus is that the Torwa interacted with those of the Christian faith.

The monument was the capital of the Torwa dynasty, which arose from the collapse of the Great Zimbabwe Kingdom between 1450 -1650 and was abandoned during the Ndebele incursions of the 19th century. It is composed of a complex series of platforms of dry-stone walled structures, emulating a later development of Stone Age culture. The chief's residence (Mambo) was located towards the north on the Hill Ruin site with its adjacent cultivation terraces. The population lived in daga huts of cobwork, surrounded by a series of granite walls. These structures display a high standard of workmanship, a great number of narrow passageways and perambulatory galleries and impressive chevron and chequered wall decorations. Khami conforms to Great Zimbabwe in a number of archaeological and architectural aspects but it possesses certain features particular to itself and its successors such as Danangombe and Zinjanja. Revetments or retaining walls found expression for the first time in the architectural history of the sub-region at Khami, and with it were elaborate decorations; it still has the longest decorated wall in the entire sub-region.

The architecture of the site and the archaeological artefacts provide evidence for an exceptional understanding of strong, united, early civilizations. They also offer information on the property's complex socio-economic, religious and spiritual significance for the local communities and for the overall chronological development of Zimbabwe tradition; initiated in Mapungubwe (South Africa), extending to Great Zimbabwe, and through the emergence of later states. The archaeological remains are also a testament to long-distance historic trade links with the Portuguese, and the wider world, the diverse range of imported artefacts provide evidence of 15th and 17th century Spanish porcelain, Rhineland stoneware and Ming porcelain, many of which are on display in the Museum of Natural History in Bulawayo. There is also a monumental granite cross which illustrates the contact with missionaries at a traditionally revered and sacred spiritual site.



Khami is the second largest stone built monument in Zimbabwe. Its historical importance lies in its position at the watershed between the history of Great Zimbabwe and the later Zimbabwe period. It is one of the few Zimbabwe sites that were not destroyed by treasure hunters and its undisturbed stratigraphy is scientifically important in providing a much clearer insight into the history of the country.

BEITBRIDGE

Beitbridge is a border town in the province of Matabeleland South, Zimbabwe. The name also refers to the border post and bridge spanning the Limpopo River, which forms the political border between South Africa and Zimbabwe. It is an area rich in archaeological and paleontological history as well as diverse wildlife. Beitbridge, the town, founded in 1929, was for many years the terminus of the railway from Pretoria.

Beitbridge, offers a unique conferencing experience and outdoor conventions. Also on offer for leisure are fishing retreats, boat cruising tours, rock art and paintings, game viewing, dinosaur fossils, 4 x 4 trail and shopping sprees across the Limpopo River (Musina). Beitbridge is home to predominantly Venda people as well as other ethnic groups such as the Shona, Ndebele, Sotho and Shangaan.

FISHING CAMP

CHIREDZI

Chiredzi located in the South East of Zimbabwe in the Masvingo Province is home to the famous sand stone Cliffs- The Chilojo Cliffs.

The south East Lowveld Region is a destination that offers an unspoiled wilderness, abundant wildlife, fascinating monuments, and spectacular recreational areas. The town, Chiredzi, together with its sister town Triangle is a major centre of sugar production in the entire country promoting Agro- Tourism.

The region has over 95% of the area taken by the Gonarezhou National Park and the Conservancies like Malilangwe and Save Valley which have giant baobabs as well as abundant birds and wildlife. Chiredzi is served by an international airport at Buffalo Range called the Buffalo Range Airport.

Gonarezhou National Park , second largest in the country after Hwange National Park covers an area in excess of 5 000 square kilometres, is an extremely scenic Park full of rugged and beautiful landscapes, contains the hidden secrets for those who know the essence of travelling. It is part of the Great Limpopo Transfrontier Park, a massive Pan-African Park that includes South Africa's famed Kruger National Park and Mozambique's Limpopo National Park. The Park offers most spectacular scenery in the region incorporating the iconic Chilojo Cliffs which lies at the heart of the Gonarezhou, extensive woodlands and wide meandering rivers forming pools and natural oases. Home to about 1 1000 elephants, Gonarezhou truly deserves its vernacular name as "Place of Elephants".

The region further houses the nine hundred and fifty hectare Chirinda Forest Botanical Reserve found in Mount Selinda, South of Chipinge, in South Eastern Zimbabwe. The densely ever green forest has a unique combination of Tropical and Subtropical vegetation species.

The forest receives very high annual rainfalls. Housing various flora and fauna, the forest is home to The Big Tree which is 65 meters tall and measures 4.5m in diameter. Its age is estimated at 1000 years or over. The region falls as a Tourism Designated Zone as it has room for investment and infrastructural development.

South Eastern Lowveld region is a central hub for cultural tourism as witnessed by hosting of annual cultural festivals throughout the year.

Victoria Falls is a town in western Zimbabwe and a gateway to the massive waterfall of the same name. Home of the 7th Wonder of the World. Victoria Falls (Mosi-oa-Tunya, "The Smoke That Thunders"; Tonga: Shungu Namutitima, "Boiling Water") is a waterfall on the Zambezi River in southern Africa, which provides habitat for several unique species of plants and animals. It is located on the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe[1] and is considered to be one of the world's largest waterfalls due to its width of 1,708 metres (5,604 ft). Here, the Zambezi River plummets over a cliff and into the Boiling Pot before flowing through a series of gorges. The Devil's Pool, a natural infinity pool, is on the edge of a sheer drop. Spanning the river is 1905 Victoria Falls Bridge. The surrounding Zambezi National Park is home to white rhinos and elephants.
